



The Devereux Early Childhood Assessment for Infants and Toddlers (DECA-I/T) is here!

Safe Schools Healthy Students and Family Care Resources will be sponsoring the one day DECA I/T certified training. It will be held on Saturday, April 21st, at St. Anne's Children and Family Center Basement Conference room, 25 W. 5th. The time will be from 8:30-4:30, light refreshments provided, however, lunch will be on your own at 12!

The DECA I/T assesses protective factors and screens for social and emotional risks in very young children. The DECA I/T is standardized, and has two tools. One to assess infants (1 month to 18 months) and one for toddlers (18 months to 36 months).

The infant version assesses two protective factor scales, Attachment/Relationships and Initiative, while the toddler version looks at three protective factor scales, Attachment/Relationships, Initiative and Self-Regulation.
